Entry and Exit Procedures

Thank you to families for your consideration and kindness as we navigate procedures during the morning entry and afternoon end of day times. A reminder to families that the parking lot is designated as a bus route space during the entry (9:00 – 9:30) and exit (3:30 – 4:00) times and is only open to staff vehicles. The parking lot is busy with students and families walking through it at entry and exit times and it is very important to ensure the safety of all community members using this space. We also recognize the significance of students attending a new grade (or school) and the want to ensure your child(ren)'s safety and well-being during this transition. During the entry process last week, there were a couple incidents where parents standing directly beside the students in line inadvertently bumped into a different families child during the entry process. If parents can stay in the area behind the white lines and allow the painted line up space to be used by students independently (supervised by staff), that would be greatly appreciated. Thank you for supporting the safety of all students.

In case of inclement weather (e.g., heavy rain or extreme temperatures), students will automatically go into the school through their assigned doors (beginning at 9:00 am) when they arrive at school first thing in the morning.
